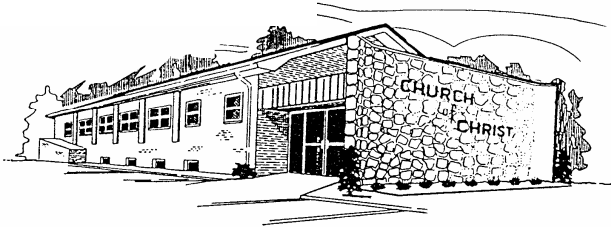

Dear Brothers and Sisters

Thank you so much for your recent contribution of \$1500 to the Haiti Disaster Relief effort being coordinated by the Estes Congregation. We are utilizing all funds received to directly help the Haitian people, especially the work of our full-time missionary, Roberta Edwards, the children she cares for at the Sonlight Children's Home, the Christians in Port-au-Prince, and the Haitians that Roberta helps feed every day through the Santo Nutrition Center. Roberta and her children have already started the relief effort by feeding 150 extra people a day – local Christians and neighbors who have lost their homes.

With funds received through our congregation, we will first ensure the safety of the children in Roberta's home by repairing the security walls surrounding the facility and any structural damage there at the nearby guesthouse so that relief workers will have a secure place to stay and work from. Along with these re-building projects, we will also attend to medical needs, feed the hungry, and purchase fuel, temporary shelter, and other necessities for living.

Our first group of medical and construction personnel recently arrived in Haiti. We hope that more groups will follow regularly. Our aid distribution will be coordinated at first through Roberta and her facility and then through the churches of Christ in the surrounding area – congregations that we work with on a regular basis through our long-term work there.
